## **HSHO** (7-10<sup>th</sup> grade) **Expectations & Commitment Form** **HIGH SCHOOL HANG OUT (HSHO) EXPECTATIONS**

- Students are expected to be respectful and follow instructions at all times. To ensure that the students & parents know and understand what will be expected, students & parents need to read this form, sign the commitment form below and it return to Crusader Care.
- After school dismissal, students walk on their own to Boatner Hall and check/sign themselves in at the front desk.
- If/when students have an athletic practice right after school, they walk over to Boatner upon completion of practice and check/sign themselves in at our front desk.
- If students have an athletic practice later in the afternoon, they come to Boatner and sign in as usual, but then sign out for practice. **Parents, please communicate your student's athletic schedule to the Crusader Care Office. This will help us immensely to know to release them to practice!** 😊
- Students will also sign themselves OUT at the front desk when a parent comes for pick-up. *Parents may call our desk to give us an estimate time of arrival or call/come to the desk when they arrive. We will radio for students to come to our Crusader Care desk in Boatner to sign out.*
- We will offer a snack item for secondary students when they check in. Students may also bring their own and will have access to the school vending machines, brownies/cupcakes (\$1 each) and drinks (\$.50-\$.75 each) from our office.
- No electronic devices are allowed while a student is checked into Crusader Care. This includes cell phones, smart watches, iPods and computers. If a student needs to do research for a school project, they can use one of the Crusader Care laptops under the supervision of one of our workers.
- Crusader Care reserves the right to take up electronic devices being used or out & visible. (Please see the PPCA Handbook online for more information on school policy.) Any devices taken up will be stored at the front desk for parents to retrieve when they pick up their student. After the 3<sup>rd</sup> time a student has a device taken up, the student must turn their device in to the front desk when they check in upon arrival.
- Students will be given time to work on homework. We do provide guidance, but not tutoring at the secondary level.
- Crusader Care reserves the right to separate students from other students for inappropriate or disruptive behavior, and in extreme cases, to suspend students from the Crusader Care program for a length of time to be determined, with the heart intent to redirect behavior.
