Although 7G-12G PPCA students may not know who their teachers are until they receive their class schedules in late July/early August, this list may help guide families as they prepare for the return to school.

Below are **some** supply lists (and wish lists) that **some** secondary teachers require for their specific classes.

NOT EVERY TEACHER HAS PROVIDED A LIST. Not every course has a supply list available online.

Many teachers will present their supply lists to students during the first week of classes.

As lists are turned in, they will be added to this online source.

NOTE to FAMILIES: Due to new students still being added and other class changes, student schedules are not made available until a week or so **before school begins**. Do not contact the school for this information. Typically, schedules are **emailed** to families and/or a notice will be sent **via text** with instruction on how to access student schedules when they become available.


