## 2022-2023 SUPPLY LISTS: 7G-12G

Updated: June 14, 2023 – subject to revision

Although 7G-12G PPCA students may not know who their teachers are until they receive their class schedules in late July/early August, this list may help guide families as they prepare for the return to school.

Below are **some** supply lists (and wish lists) that **some** secondary teachers require for their specific classes.

**NOT EVERY TEACHER HAS PROVIDED A LIST. Not every course has a supply list available online.**

Many teachers will present their supply lists to students during the first week of classes.

As lists are turned in, they will be added to this online source.

**NOTE to FAMILIES:** Due to new students still being added and other class changes, student schedules are not made available until a week or so **before school begins**. Do not contact the school for this information. Typically, schedules are **emailed** to families and/or a notice will be sent **via text** with instruction on how to access student schedules when they become available.

- Colored Pencils, Markers, and Crayons: Standard Crayola brand is fine for all of these, but students are welcome to bring another type.

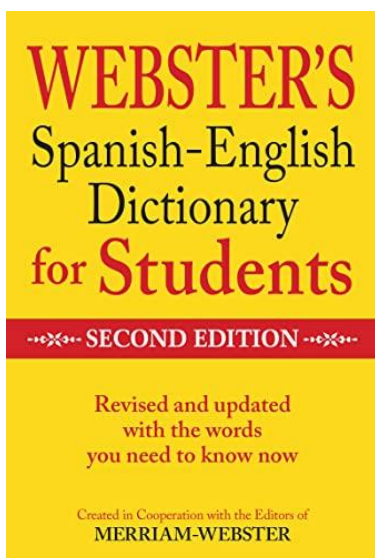
### **EARTH SCIENCE (8th Grade) and PHYSICAL SCIENCE (9th Grade):**

- Notebook (1-subject for 7/8, but a 3-subject for Spanish I and Spanish II)
- 1 Package of Loose-leaf paper
- Pencils
- Webster Spanish-English Dictionary is required for Spanish I and Spanish II
- Webster Spanish-English Dictionary is recommended for Spanish 7/8.
