GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS (as stated on pages 51-52 in Student Handbook):

Beginning with the 2023-2024 school year, to graduate from PPCA, each student must complete a **minimum of forty (40) service hours**, in addition to fulfilling the academic requirements for graduation. These 40 service hours will be in addition to **two (2) service projects per year**, per grade level, as overseen by PPCA's Bible department chairperson, **Mr. Dwayne Kelly**.

The requirements for A.C.T.S. hours will be ten (10) hours per year in grades 9th through 12th, with five (5 hours) to be earned each semester. Underclassmen will be held accountable for these hours through a final grade each semester that counts as 20% of their grade for the semester in their Bible classes. Any hours earned that exceed the required 10 hours per year will count toward earning a cord at graduation.

Note: Half of the A.C.T.S. hours must be earned **during** the academic school year.

All A.C.T.S. hours must be turned in by the **last day of school in April** to count for that year.
