SUPPLY LIST FOR K5-5TH GRADE

- Daily, students should have a water bottle **labeled with their name** and grade. *Bottles should be sent filled with **WATER ONLY** and should close and seal to prevent leaking.*
- **K5-1st students** should have an **Extra set of Clothes** in a bag labeled with their name & grade and kept in their backpacks, *including socks, underwear, shirt and bottoms **labeled with their name.*** These extra clothes can be modest & appropriate play clothes and do NOT have to be school uniforms.
- **Suggestion for 4th-5th grade girls:** have an emergency bag stored in their backpacks with feminine products & undies for 1st starts or accidents. Store in a cute, non-see through and closable bag.
- Cell phones, smart or otherwise, and smart watches should remain at home (or at least stay in backpacks). Students who NEED to make a call may do so with permission on a PPCA Crusader Care phone under the supervision of our staff. ***Any phones visible or used without permission will be taken up and stored at the Crusader Care desk to return to the parent. After the 2nd time a device is taken up, the student then turns in their device to the front desk when checking into Crusader Care.***
- On full camp days (7:15am-6:00pm) & on early dismissal days, K5-6th may bring small toys that easily fit in their backpacks, *but NOT Pokemon cards.* **Please only send items that you know have not been recently exposed to others unless the items have been disinfected. Thank you!**
